Clifford Eberly traces his interest in art and culture to high school, where his art teacher encouraged him to pursue a creative path. In 1992, he graduated from the Savannah College of Art and Design with a BFA in Fibers, and afterward completed an internship program at the Fabric Workshop in Philadelphia. His creative path then led him to New York City,

where he maintained an art studio and worked in a fabric showroom, and later to Lancaster, PA where he founded and directed the Parlor Gallery.

Clifford studied studio art at Clairmont Graduate University in California, and remained in Los Angeles until 2021, where he participated in numerous exhibitions and received the Curators Lab Grant from the Fellows of Contemporary Art. In early 2022, Clifford and his husband relocated to Doylestown to be closer to their families. As Exhibitions Associate at the Hicks Art Center Gallery at Bucks County Community College, he curates seven to eight exhibitions per year. In January 2023, he was appointed to the board of directors of the Arts and Cultural Council of Bucks County and in 2024 to the board of the New Hope Colony Foundation for the Arts.
